

University Digitisation Service

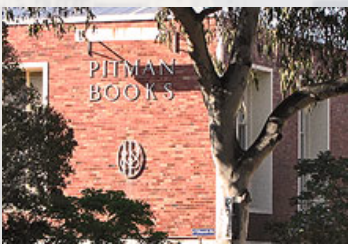


The UDS is an in-house unit based in the University Library providing digitisation of collection items from the University's many collections for the purposes of teaching, research and preservation.

In 2012, UDS are running a minor project to investigate the development of a crosswalk from MARC21 catalogue records to XMP metadata for the purposes of increasing the amount of metadata embedded in digitised files.

This will include the development of a set of generic tools and methodologies to collect, transform and embed a range of metadata into a variety of digital files including PDF, TIF and JPG.
